Cambridge Midwives is a well-established practice of 10-12 midwives, with differing caseloads and practice models. We have a newly renovated and accessible office with five clinic rooms overlooking the scenic Grand River. We use Accuro EMR for charting and scheduling appointments, and have two full time support staff who provide excellent communication and assistance. We strongly encourage work/life balance, and have implemented protocols for oncall sleep relief and call coverage.

Cambridge Midwives practices full scope at our level 2 hospital, which boasts an inviting new birthing wing. The midwives enjoy a comfortable and friendly rapport with hospital staff, and are well-integrated into all pertinent units. We have our own Chief of Midwifery, and have regular Midwifery Department meetings, as well as being incorporated into joint department meetings with Obstetrics, Pediatrics, and Anesthesia.

Cambridge is well situated near Kitchener-Waterloo and Guelph, as well as being approximately one hour from Toronto and London. It has a historic small-town feel, with many local establishments, community events and live music, walking and biking trails, and scenic churches and architecture.
