

AOM Rural Locum Position Available

Are you ready to bring your midwifery skills to the coolest town by the bay?

Midland Midwives is looking for a locum midwife to provide holiday relief for our rural practice. The locum would need to be available for prenatal and postpartum visits, as well as births in the primary and secondary role. Hospital privileges are at Georgian Bay General Hospital (Midland). We currently maintain care for epidurals and transfer care for oxytocin.

Our practice boasts exceptional hospital relations, as well as a strong partnership with our local community health centre Chigamik. We share the goal of providing exceptional and culturally safe care for the large Indigenous and Francophone populations of the area.

Payment will be through the AOM Rural and Remote Locum Program. This program provides funding to cover additional accommodation, food and moving expenses. Coverage needs are flexible but vacation for midwives is currently planned over the months of December, January and March. We work in a shared call model, with regularly scheduled time off in the rotation. You could potentially come and go from the area between coverage dates to accommodate other priorities. Enjoy your days off in beautiful cottage country with access to skiing, hiking and more! Or head to the big city of Toronto which is only a 90 minute drive.

We hope to conduct interviews in October, but the posting will remain up until the locum position is filled
