Forest City Midwifery C.A.R.E. (formerly Womancare Midwives) is looking for (2) New Registrants to join our well-established practice of 12 midwives.

With a catchment area encompassing the city of London and privileges at London Health Sciences Centre (LHSC - Victoria Campus – level 3), our practice is seeking two full-time New Registrants to help us serve our diverse community.

Forest City Midwifery C.A.R.E.(FCMC) supports a mixture of primary and shared-care call structures as well as full and part-time caseload options. This flexibility encourages excellent work-life balance for those who practice at our clinic. FCMC strives to provide a supportive working environment and has a long tradition of mentorship for New Registrants. FCMC also welcomes collaboration – not just with each other, but with community health care providers as well.

The Department of Midwifery at LHSC is unlike any in Canada, with unique structures to support research and academic opportunities. Our department has a successful EMCM in the TIME program, in which midwives employed at the hospital work alongside Maternal Fetal Medicine Specialists to provide care to pregnant people who would normally not be eligible for midwifery care. This funding recently expanded to include an Early Discharge Program for patients of Family Doctors and Obstetricians to receive care by midwives after delivery. We also have a midwife-run bilirubin blood work clinic at the hospital.

Our spacious clinic, which is conveniently located across the road from LHSC Victoria Campus, has 5 clinic rooms, 2 washrooms, a kitchen and a large comfy meeting room as well as providing ample free parking for midwives and clients. We employ two full-time support staff to keep our practice running smoothly.

We are seeking hardworking, driven applicants who have exceptional communication skills, are team players and are dedicated to providing clients with informed choice. BIPOC midwives and midwives capable of providing care in languages other than English are encouraged to apply. We are a full-scope department, and while we can provide training, preference will be given to those with experience providing oxytocin induction/augmentation and running epidurals.

Of note: Womancare Midwives was established over 30 years ago in London and effective July 25, 2022 we have now become Forest City Midwifery C.A.R.E. The acronym stands for Choice, Advocacy, Respect and Empowerment. Our intention in changing our name was to reflect the principles of diversity, equity in health care and inclusivity to the greatest degree. It is important to our practice that pregnant people in this community who do not identify as women feel safe to seek care from our clinic.
