Midwives are very well integrated into our hospital culture. We have trusting relationships with our hospital colleagues which are reflective of the value the hospital places on midwives. We work full scope (including managing epidurals and oxytocin). The department provides and supports many opportunities for mentoring and preceptorship, including both midwifery and medical students. Midwives working in the LHSC Midwifery Department are encouraged to become adjunct professors through McMaster University. The department is committed to supporting midwives in developing new models of midwifery work both in the hospital and in our community. Additionally, we have recently received EMCM funding which provides further opportunities for an OB client early discharge program run by midwives in the community.

Located between Toronto and Windsor, London is a vibrant, growing and affordable city. Known as the Forest City, London has many beautiful parks, accessible trails winding around the Thames River and easy access to nature conservatories. There are many music, art and culture festivals throughout the year with a vibrant nightlife and ample ways to relax in your downtime.
