We are a well-established practice with deep roots in our community; Midwives of Muskoka is now in its 18th year of operation. We are a dynamic and growing practice with a large catchment area that extends from Orillia to Emsdale and everything in between. Muskoka is in the traditional territories of the Anishnaabeg, which includes the Ojibwe, Odawa, and Potawatomi Nations, collectively known as the Three Fires Confederacy.

Our midwives hold privileges at 3 different hospital sites in addition to having a thriving culture of homebirth (30-40%). We are a practice of 5 full-time midwives and are looking for someone to join our growing team. At Muskoka Algonquin Healthcare (Bracebridge and Huntsville Hospitals) we work to our full scope, managing oxytocin and epidurals. At Orillia Soldiers Memorial Hospital (level 2) we manage epidurals and are currently in the process of developing rollout protocols for oxytocin induction and augment for midwives.

We are seeking a midwife who feels passionate about our role as autonomous care providers and advocates; who reflects values of collaboration and respect and who appreciates going out for breakfast after births.

Our group will have a caseload built for an incoming midwife and our mentorship includes having a midwife present with you for births until you feel competent and safe to practice independently. Midwives of Muskoka are also fortunate to have amazing admin and support staff and beautiful clinic space in a century home in the heart of downtown Bracebridge.

We welcome applications from midwives with varied personal and professional experience, including Indigenous midwives and others who are prepared to actively engage in reconciliation action with our practice and local communities.
